Originally designed by Swiss architect Robert Haussmann in 1965 for the Ingolstadt theater. Solid brass bars and spheres, in a zigzag arrangements of points and connections, available in many lengths and configurations, all suspended by delicate braided stainless cables. Shown in Polished Nickel.

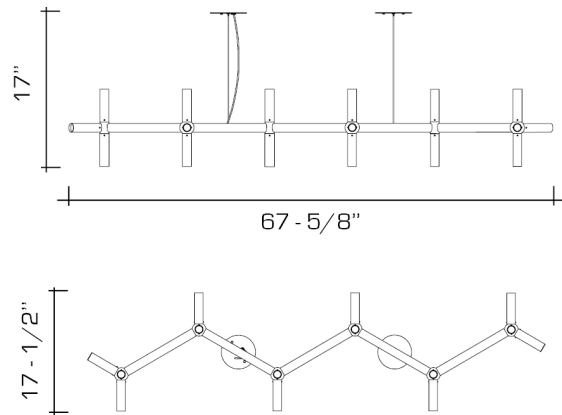
