SPLASHING WATER TABLE LAMP

Inspired by the chandeliers Tony Duquette designed for the opening gala of his Robertson Boulevard studios in 1956, this table light of delicate metal ribs with a clear base illuminates sprays of drops held still above and below the shade. Shown in Gloss White.

Overall: 41" h. x 22" diameter

Height to socket: 31-1/4"

Shade: 13" h. x 20" top diameter x 22" bottom diameter

Base: 2-1/4" h. x 8" diameter

2 Edison sockets, maximum 75 watts per socket

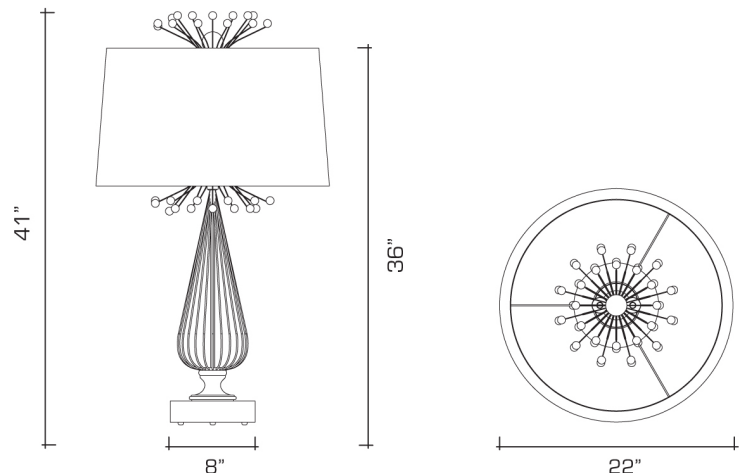
